1-4 Stage 1: Round Robin groups of 3 or 4 players; 1st and 2nd advance
Stage 2: Knock-Out
5-6 Stage 1: Round Robin
Final Stage: Round Robin (group of 6 players)
Stage 2 will be decided by Competition Manager and Referee according
to number of entries
7-10 World Championships Team format
*In all events, all matches are BEST OF 5, except Stage 2 of MS and WS which will be BEST of 7

11. Seeding list: According to the last available World Ranking. Players who do not have a World
Ranking will be ranked according to the latest Canadian or USA rating.

19. Racket Controls:

Racket Control includes official test for VOC, miniRAE device will be used according to the ITTF decision. The ITTF Equipment Committee strongly recommends all players make certain that new coverings are aired 72 hours before use

Racket Control tests will be carried out after the match at random. However, from the quarterfinals on, Racket Control tests will be carried out before selected matches of individual events and the randomly selected individual matches in all team matches. Rackets that do not pass the Racket Control test before the match cannot be used in the above-mentioned events. In the case where rackets do not pass a random Racket Control test after the match, the offending player will be liable to penalties.

All players are entitled to have their rackets tested voluntarily without any penalties before the match.
